FALL ARCHITECTURE TOURS AT THE FLORIDA HISTORIC CAPITOL MUSEUM

FROM DOORKNOBS TO DOMES: *The Architectural History of Florida's Historic Capitol*

The Florida Historic Capitol Museum is pleased to offer a weekly one-hour architectural tour entitled *From Doorknobs to Domes: The Architectural History of Florida's Historic Capitol*.

During the program, guests will explore the Historic Capitol Building, focusing on its construction in 1845, the 1902 additions and its restoration in the 1980s. The tour will start in the rotunda and proceed to various locations on the first and second floors, including the restored Governor's Suite, Supreme Court and Legislative Chambers. This program will be held at 2 PM every Friday, starting on September 9 and running through December 9.

These tours will be led by Howard Rich, an architectural woodworker and master craftsman, who developed an intimate knowledge of the Historic Capitol since he participated in its restoration in the 1980s. For over 30 years, as the owner of Rich Wood Turning & Stairworks in Miami, FL, Mr. Rich worked throughout the southeast and Caribbean, on various state capitols, museums and the National Palace in Haiti.
